country at an approved center, obtain a police clearance certificate, and have their educational documents attested by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Kuwaiti Embassy. After arriving in Kuwait, the final step involves a local medical test and fingerprinting to secure the residency permit, known as the “Iqama,” and a Civil ID card. We will provide you with the necessary information and digital guidance on where to track your application and how to follow official government steps.

To apply, please submit your updated resume and a clear copy of your passport. Candidates who meet the initial criteria will be invited for a virtual interview. Following a successful interview, you will receive an offer letter which allows you to start the visa guidance phase.
